~ **February 12th - Community Health Ministries.**

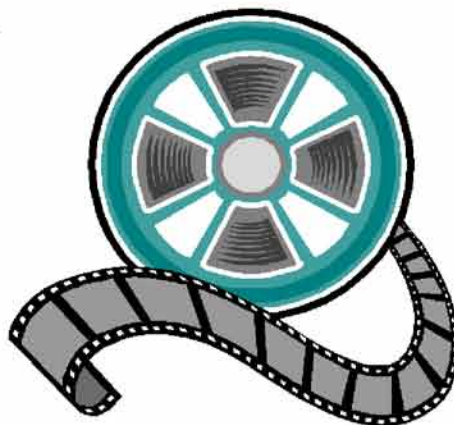
Please bring one or more cans of tomato soup or strawberry jelly. **Movie: Pay it Forward**

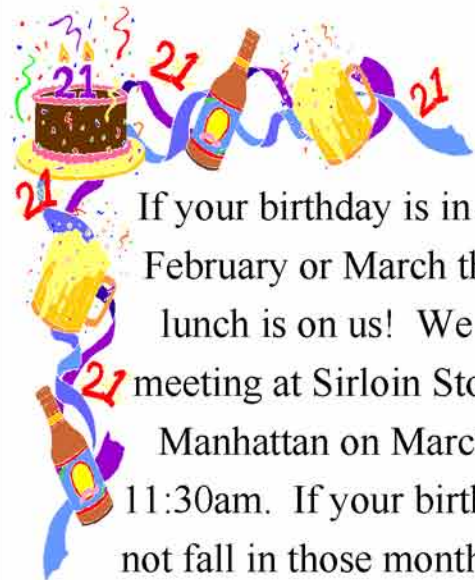
